Legumes like fo'ul & Flafel

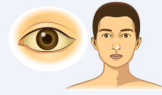
Drugs as

Co-trimazole (septrin\ Bactrim), nalidixic acid, sulfonamide, chloroquine primaquine, chloramphenicol, nitrofurantoin, vit K analogs, high dose aspirin, naphthalene, etc.

Hemolytic Crisis Symptoms



- Dark, tea-colored pee



- Jaundice
(the skin and eyes look yellow)



- Shortness of breath



- Tiredness



- Loss of appetite for food or vomiting.
